They may or may not be National Academy members. Candidates should be super stars in a performing, journalistic, creative, technical, educational, or administrative role with the industry. Selection will consider service to: the general community, the television industry, the National Academy, and the training of others for careers in television.

Candidates must have more than longevity to their credit; they must be truly outstanding in their contribution to both the television industry and their communities.
